I am writing you as a result of your recent contribution to New Life Community Center's Food Pantry. Since we opened our doors, over ten years ago, New Life Community Center has provided programs which uplift, empower, and impact residents in the surrounding South DeKalb Community. New Life is a faith-based, 501© 3 organization. The programs and services that we offer provide education, job skills training, as well as family and individual enrichment activities for all area residents. The goals of uplifting, empowering, and impacting our residents is important because these goals enable us to teach residents to become self-sufficient.

Your contribution has aided us in impacting lives through two different ministries. His Love Extended provides comprehensive services of Metro Atlanta's homeless men, women, and children. These services include: Transportation to New Life Community Center and back to the homeless shelters, cooked meals during their visit to New Life, hair cuts, showers, and clothing for those who request them, motivational messages, and life skill classes. Gatherings are held on Saturday mornings from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Another program which will benefit from your donations is our Food Pantry. Through our Food Pantry, many families within our community who are at-risk of homelessness are provided non-perishable food items.

So far in 2013, we have fed 16,038 meals through our community feeding ministries and distributed 109,438 lbs of non-perishable food to 2,392 community households through our food pantry.
